
Jehu

- Elisha selected
- Outsider who sought reform
- Rough around the edges
- Fighter, alpha male
- Defeated Jezebel and killed all Ahab's family
- Zeal without submission
- Best of the northern kings
- Did not finish well (idolatry)

Joash and Jehoiada

^{2 Chronicles 24:17} After the death of Jehoiada, the officials of Judah came and paid homage to the king, and he listened to them. ¹⁸ They abandoned the temple of the LORD, the God of their ancestors, and worshiped Asherah poles and idols. Because of their guilt, God's anger came on Judah and Jerusalem. ¹⁹ Although the LORD sent prophets to the people to bring them back to him, and though they testified against them, they would not listen.

²⁰ Then the Spirit of God came on Zechariah son of Jehoiada the priest. He stood before the people and said, "This is what God says: 'Why do you disobey the LORD's commands? You will not prosper. Because you have forsaken the LORD, he has forsaken you.'"

- Primary themes are injustice, poverty, pride, complacency, and God's omnipotence and divine judgment.



Amos 7:14 "I was neither a prophet nor the son of a prophet, but I was a shepherd, and I also took care of sycamorefig trees. ¹⁵ But the LORD took me from tending the flock and said to me, 'Go, prophesy to my people Israel.'


Amos 4:1 Hear this word, you cows of Bashan on Mount Samaria,

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."




