




### **Unity of Christians by following New Testament: 1**st Generation

- Where the Bible speaks, we speak.
   Where the Bible is silent, we are silent.
- In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things love.
- The church of Jesus Christ on earth is essentially, intentionally, and constitutionally one.
- No creed but Christ, no book but the Bible, no law but love, no name but the divine.
- We are not the only Christians; we are Christians only.




# The Dark Ages of Controversy and Stagnation

- Etc.




### Civil War

- American Christian Missionary Society
  - loyalty resolutions

Wealth disparity

- All denominations split
  - the Christian Churches and Churches of Christ stuck together the longest

- Central Christian Church in Cincinnati, Ohio
- Built new French Gothic style building in 1872
- Seated 2000, stained glass, organ, choir pit
- Cost = \$140,000



#### Musical Instruments

- The lightning rod of dispute
- Log cabins to stained glass and choir lofts
- 1872 Central Christian Church, Cincinnati
- Sand Creek Church of Christ Daniel Sommer
   1889
- Non-instrumental Church of Christ split became official in census of 1906:
  - Churches of Christ (non-instrumental):
     159,658 members
  - Christian Churches: 982,701 members



### Bold New Strides


(1874-1900)



# Churches of Christ Issues in the 21st Century

- Strengths
  - Education and Publishing
  - People: Strong evangelistic spirit, excellent character, loyal
  - Unity movement developing with Christian Churches
- Issues to Address
  - Stagnating Membership (peaked in 1955)
  - Music (instruments, choir, special music, style)
  - Modern Culture: Divisions, Exclusivist Attitude, Women's Roles
  - Generational Differences




Our position on the music issue has probably done more to damage our reputation than has any other single thing. By taking a position which is so obviously false (to everyone but ourselves) we have destroyed the credibility of our whole approach to Bible study. It has ruined our reputation throughout Christendom. We have much Bible truth to offer the world, such as the importance of baptism, in connection with faith and repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, but people won't take us seriously largely, I think, because we have destroyed our credibility with the music issue.












### Prominent Members of Disciples







### Spectrum of the Restoration Movement
